Course Overview

This course has been thoughtfully crafted in partnership with LBAT KOREA. For students aiming to accrue 12 credits in the summer semester, it is strongly advised to enroll in this course as a precursor to participating in the LBAT KOREA Program.

In this enriching course, students are afforded the rare chance to immerse themselves fully in the vibrant tapestry of traditional Korean arts, with a special emphasis on its musical heritage for two weeks at Jindo National Gugak Center in Korea. Through comprehensive regional historical and cultural tours encompassing key historical museums and historically significant sites featured in renowned films, students will be transported through the pivotal moments that shaped Korean history for one week.

This course navigates the evolution of Korea from the Three Kingdoms Era right up to 1980, employing an engaging medium of Korean films complemented by the melodious soundtracks and original scores from popular dramas. This multi-sensory approach not only fosters a robust understanding of Korea's rich historical narrative but also sets a vivid backdrop for the exploration of famed historical landmarks scattered across the country.

Program fees: \$1,500

Lodging, food, and lessons in Jindo are provided by the Korean Government for free. You have only to purchase a round-trip flight ticket, exclusive of tuition, \$1,025.79.

Course Goals and Learning Outcomes

By the culmination of the course, students will:

- 1. Develop a nuanced understanding of traditional Korean arts, reflecting on the intricate layers of its culture, history, and society.
- 2. Be adept at articulating insights into Korea's historical landmarks and societal complexities.
- 3. Transform into eloquent advocates for Korean heritage, translating their enriched knowledge into insightful narratives and discussions.

Course Format

This course blends in-person experiences and virtual learning, encompassing:

- 1. A two-week program at the Jindo National Gugak Center, involving traditional musical instrument training, percussion quartet sessions, and cultural explorations at local historical sites.
- 2. Pre-visit movie viewings and readings to foster a rich contextual understanding before site visits.
- 3. Excursions to historical sites for firsthand exploration and learning.

Assessment Components

- 1. Movie and Reading Discussions (15%): Engage with assigned materials to deepen understanding before site visits.
- 2. Performance Assessment (65%): Evaluate skills acquired in traditional musical instrument and Samulnori performances.
- 3. Final Project (20%): Develop a video project encapsulating learnings from a chosen movie (details below).

Final Project - Due May 30, 2024, 11:59 PM

Select a movie from the course list that resonated with you the most. Create a captivating video that introduces the film's director, release date, cast, and synopsis, coupled with the historical backdrop, and insights gained from the course. The video should span a minimum of 5 minutes to a maximum of 10 minutes.

Project Selection Deadline: May 24, 2024, 11:59 PM

Rubric:

- 1. Content Mastery (50%): Effective presentation of Korean history and critical analysis of the chosen film/historical site, targeting audiences with limited prior knowledge.
- 2. Presentation Skills (50%): Clear and engaging video presentation.

May 11-13: Seoul: Gyeongbokgung – The sword with no name (Geoncheonggung 1, 2, 3) & If I leave

Incheon – Man of will Seongnam – The fortress Suwon – Memory of the World Wonhaeng Eulmyojeongri Eugye Yesan – Feng Shui

Gongju/Buyeo – Once upon a time in a battlefield (filming location- Jeonju)

May 19-20: Visiting historical sites in Jeju Island

May 21-24 Learning traditional musical instrument & Samulnori, cultural experience (making a fan), cultural exploration (watching sunset), performance, and closing ceremony

May 25 - May 26: Jindo-Suncheon – Malmoe, Yeosun Rising Namhae – Noryang Tongyoung (Hansan filming location)/Hansan- Hansan Geoje – Swing Kids


May 26 - May 27:
